

Ohio School Resource Officers Association presents  
**School Resource Officer (SRO) Basic Training**

**Monday – Friday, October 11-15, 2021**

**Due to the continuing effects of Covid-19 this training will be held virtually using the Zoom meeting platform**

Creating and maintaining a safer school environment is the primary goal of every SRO. This OPOTA approved, HB 318 compliant five-day training assists SROs in equipping themselves with the information and skills needed to identify, address and prevent crime and violence in Ohio schools. The 40-hour curriculum will cover SROs major responsibilities as well as Ohio School Laws, Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) for SROs, tips on integrating the SRO into the school environment and more. The format is a combination of live webinars and self-study. Participants must pass a final assessment (80% or higher).

Certificates are distributed at the end of the final day of training to students who attend all sessions and successfully complete course exercises. **Attendees must have access to an individual computer with audio/camera and must attend with web camera turned on.**

**Please note: This course is for sworn law enforcement officers who are currently (or will be soon) assigned to a school.**

### **Instructors**

Instructors are a combination of certified Ohio School Resource Officers, professionals in the fields of school law, education, child development/advocacy, current drug trends/awareness and other subject matter experts.

**Morning sessions begin at 8:00 a.m. and afternoon sessions end by 5:00 p.m.** (times may vary).

### **Cost:**

Registration is \$375. Fee includes materials and one-year OSROA Membership.

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

Agencies registering more than one SRO and sharing technology must provide an individual email address for each registrant.

Agencies that choose to use a classroom setting with multiple SROs in attendance must establish one SRO as the daily attendance contact.

Each registrant may provide two email addresses (i.e. home and work) to which daily correspondence will be sent during the dates of and pertaining to the training.
