- **Legal - Slightly Different Perspective** – Learn what the legal approach is to protecting students and why SROs are an important component to the overall safeguard of students and the school community.
- **ASSET Awareness for SROs** – SROs need to have a better understanding of HB 99 and the *Armed School Staff Essential Training Program*.
- **Legal – School Law Update** – Receive updated and reminders of school associated laws while being an SRO.
- **CPTED for School Based Policing** – Learn the entry level aspects of CPTED and improve your campus safety practices.

- **SROs & The Recovery Process** – SROs are key players in the aftermath crisis response plan. Learn how to better serve your school community in the event of a crisis.
