- **TECIP Awareness** - The Traumatic Event Crisis Intervention Plan (TECIP™), a program developed and taught to schools and districts how to develop sound aftermath crisis response plans, along with providing practical strategies and support materials in helping those impacted.
- **Legal - Slightly Different Perspective** – Learn what the legal approach is to protecting students and why SROs are an important component to the overall safeguard of students and the school community.
- **School Safety Overview** – Refresh the purpose of school-based policing.
- **The SRO Roles in Schools** – Know the changing expectations and responsibilities.
- **Threat Assessments & The SRO** – Understand the SRO role in threat assessments.
- **SROs & Incident Action Plans** – Gain knowledge in developing action plans for extracurricular after school activities.
- **Current Threats/Trends to Schools** – SROs need to be aware of the current trends that are disrupting educational environments.
